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### GOING DEEPER

1. The ark plays a prominent role in the crossing of the Jordan and the upcoming marches around Jericho. What do you know about the ark? What was in it and dwelt on it? (See Exodus 25:10-22, 16:31-35; Numbers 17:10; 2 Kings 19:15; Psalms 99:1 and Hebrews 9:4.)

2. Based on what was in it and dwelt above it, what did the ark signify?
3. What is the significance of the ark for us now?
4. They had the ark as a specific physical location of God's presence. How do we know that the Lord is among us since we don't have that tangible symbol? (See John 14:15-19, 25-27; Acts 1:8; Ephesians 1:13-14.)
5. If you are a follower of Christ, describe something you have experienced or an effect on your heart because the Spirit is in you.
6. The stones from the Jordan were to remind the people of God's faithfulness, power, might and supremacy (Joshua 4:4-7, 19-24). What methods do you use to remember God's faithfulness?
7. What is a specific circumstance that God brought you through that reminds you of His faithfulness? How does that encourage you in something you are facing today?
