THINCS TO KNOW

Thank you for sending your child to VBS at Foothills Bible Church! We are glad to have your family participate with us.

- Tennis shoes and sunscreen are recommended.

- Important check-in and check-out procedures:

4/5 year old's:

- Class assignments will be posted as you enter the lower level (go left when you pull in to the church parking lot).
- Your child will go to the same classroom each day.
- Check-in your child on the computers in the lower lobby.
- ◆ Two tags will print, one tag will go on your child & the other tag will go on the check-in sheet at the classroom door.
- You will receive a pick up tag with a 3 digit code, you need that tag in order to pick up your child after VRS.
- ♦ Please pick up at 12:00 p.m..
- If a different person is picking up your child, you will need to be sure they have the pick up tag in their possession.

Kindergarten—4th Graders

Here:

- Join the Welcome Team! It is a fun way to serve at your church.
- Help us provide a night of fun and faith to those with special needs by volunteering at All Stars Club.
- Pray for church leaders—Pastors, Leaders, and Staff. Ask them for requests or send them a note that you are praying for them.
- Invite a friend to VBS!

Near:

- Pray for your neighbors. Walk the block each week and pray for their families, children, hurts and heartaches, and for them to know Jesus' love.
- Sign-up for a ministry organizations prayer email and pray for them when you receive updates and requests.
- Bring a meal to someone. Whether that is a neighbor, someone on the prayer list at your church, teachers at your neighborhood school, or those in need through an organization like Open Door Ministries.
- Buy or collect foods for a local food bank like Mean Street Ministries. Currently they need canned soup, canned fruit, canned meat, and peanut butter.

Everywhere:

- Sign-up for a missionary's prayer email and pray for them when you receive updates and requests. Find where they are working on a map, learn about the people they serve, and try food from that country.
- Sponsor a child through Compassion International.
